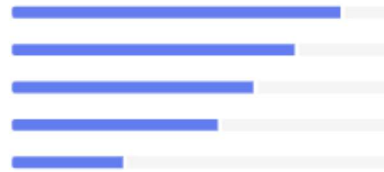

1. What would be, in your opinion, the main incentive that would motivate you to participate, continuously and in a real context, in requests for energy flexibility?

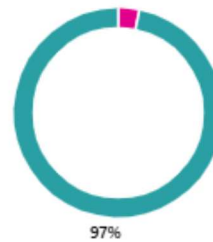
Sort by importance:

- 5 Voluntary participation without the need for any incentive



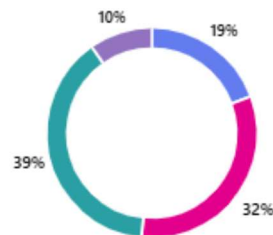
2. What types of consumption reduction situations would you be willing to participate in?

4. How many requests for consumption reduction would you be willing to receive on the same day?



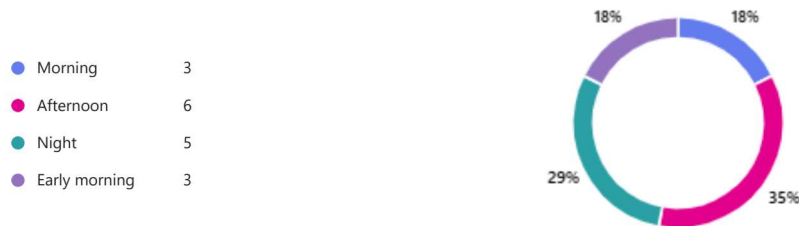
5. On which days of the week are you most comfortable participating in consumption reduction actions?



6. At what time(s) of the day are you available to temporarily reduce energy consumption? (Business days)

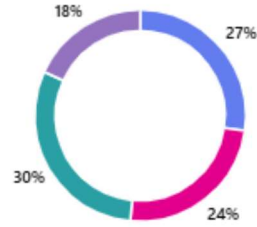


7. At what time(s) of the day are you available to temporarily reduce energy consumption? (Weekends)



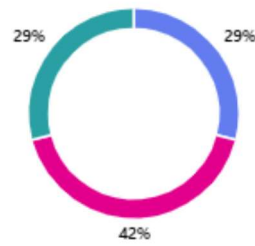
8. At what time(s) of the day are you available to temporarily reduce energy consumption? (Any day)
